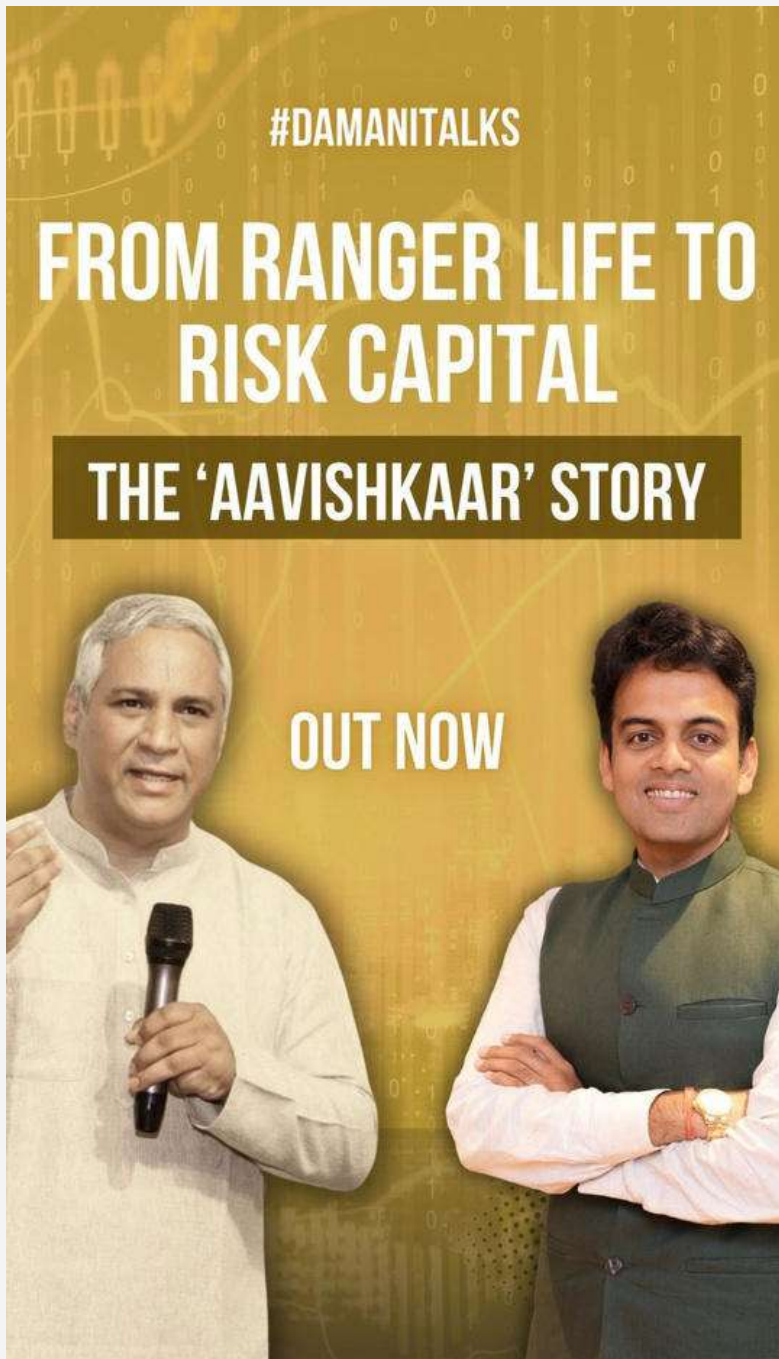

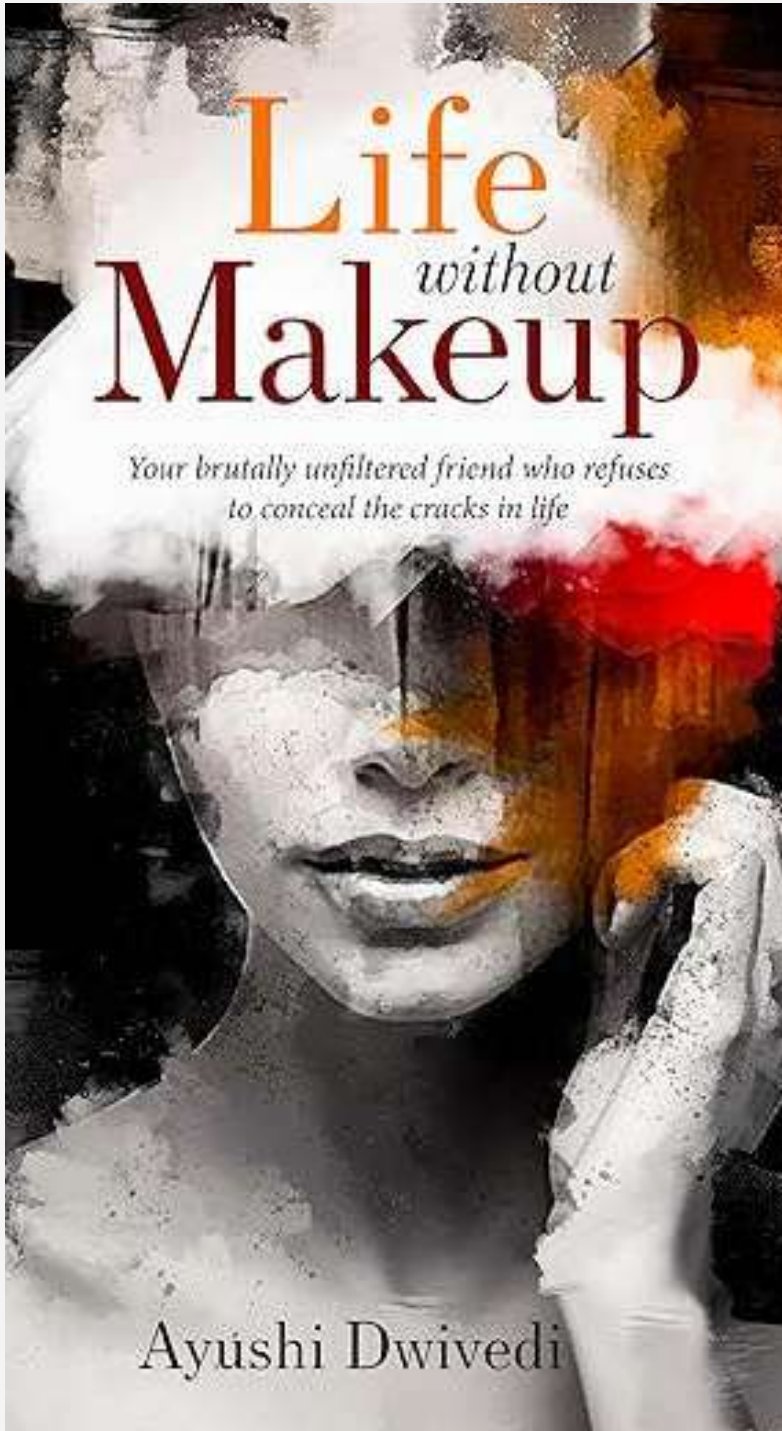

The IIFMight @NASA-Munish Sikka(PFM 2009) has got a newly published dataset that provides monthly estimates of sea level changes using data from the GRACE and GRACE-FO satellites (since April 2002). It reports contributions from regions such as Greenland, Antarctica, mountain glaciers, and other land areas, highlighting their influence on sea level.

The files include maps of ground deformation, sea surface changes, and global mean sea level, and will be updated regularly which we can see here

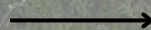

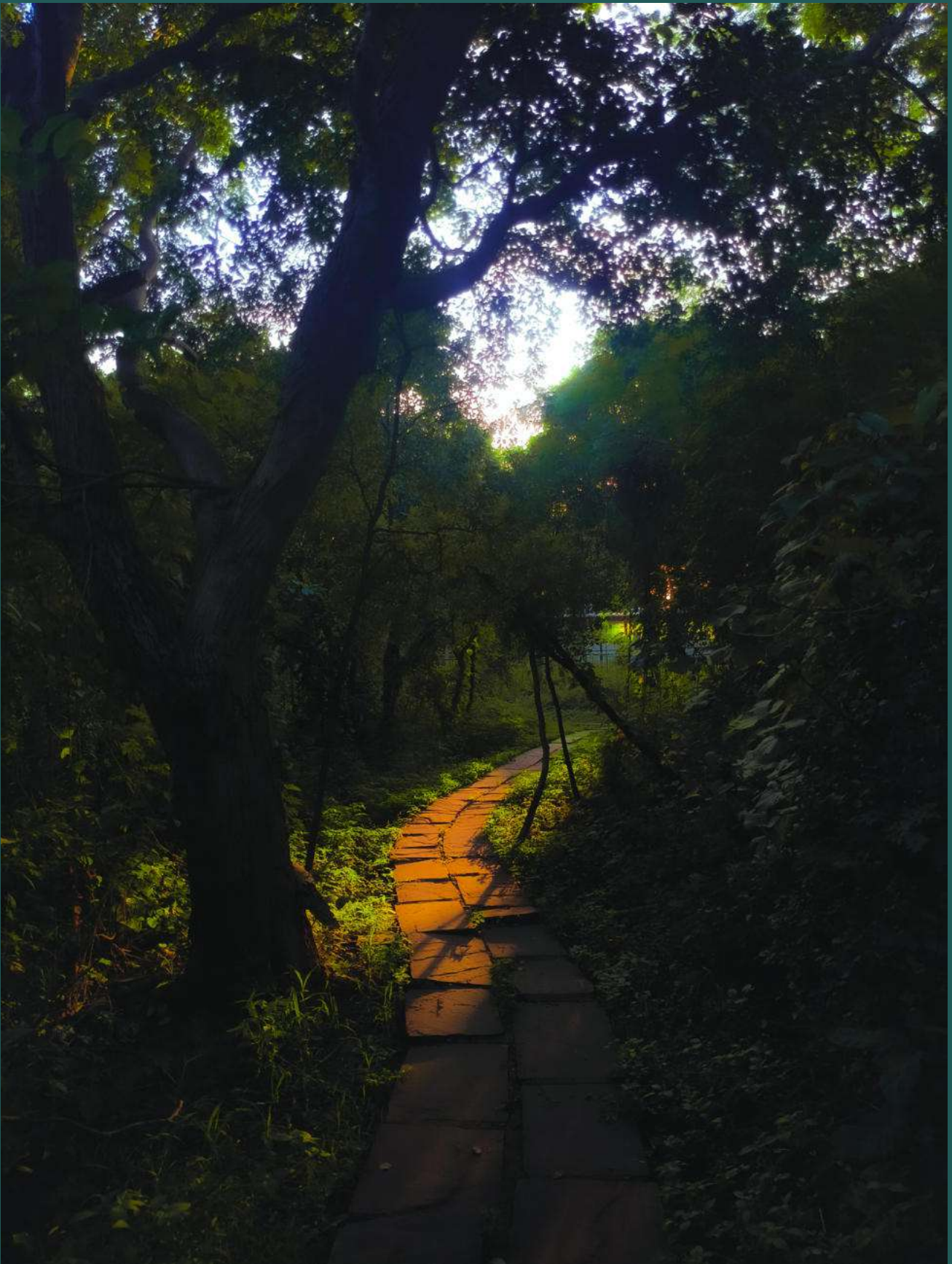
Greta Thunberg: Raising the Alarm in a World at War

Greta Thunberg has long been a powerful voice in the global climate movement, inspiring millions to demand urgent action on the climate crisis. In 2025, her activism took a bold turn as she linked climate justice with human rights amidst the Israel-Palestine conflict.

In June 2025, Thunberg joined the Global Sumud Flotilla, a convoy of over 50 boats attempting to break the Israeli naval blockade of Gaza to deliver humanitarian aid amid a worsening famine. The flotilla carried essential supplies like baby formula, medical kits, and water desalination equipment. However, Israeli forces intercepted the convoy in international waters, detaining over 470 activists, including Thunberg.

During her detention, Thunberg and others reported mistreatment. She later spoke publicly about the harsh conditions but emphasized that the larger issue is the ongoing humanitarian crisis and war in Gaza. After deportation to Greece, she called out the international community for failing to prevent war crimes and called for more than symbolic gestures to end the siege and suffering.

PROCESS OF SEEKING SUPPORT FROM EMERGENCY FUND

EMERGENCY SUPPORT FUND OF THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF IIFM AIMS TO EXTEND TIMELY FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO IIFM ALUMNI DURING TIMES OF DISTRESS.



ELIGIBILITY & GRANT CRITERIA

- The applicant must be a registered member of the IIFM Alumni Association.
- Support is provided in the case of: Prolonged or critical illness, Major accident, Permanent disability, etc.
- Maximum support amount is INR 50,000 per request. Disbursement is subject to availability of funds. In cases where needs exceed INR 50,000, the AA may assist in additional fundraising efforts.

SUBMIT A REQUEST

Alumni or their family can reach out to the Alumni Association by email or phone with their request. In medical cases, a report must be attached, and two AA members should support the request. The assistance can be a Grant or Loan.

DOCUMENT VERIFICATION & REVIEW

The Board will review the documents, and the Manager will help fill any gaps if needed. The Manager and Secretary submit the proposal to the Board, which then reviews and votes on it.

DECISION & DISBURSEMENT

If approved by majority vote, a decision is made at the earliest and funds are released. The spirit here is to support when in need and, when feasible, return or donate to help replenish the fund for others in the future.

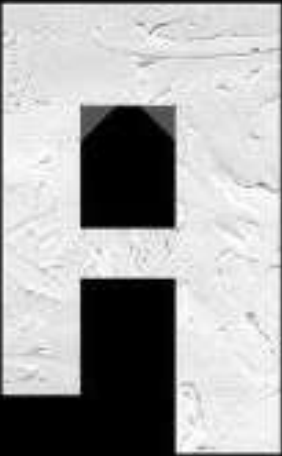
